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
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

01.1 | Introduction







02.1 | Remnant Green Patches




Remnant Green and Public Areas

It seemed appropriate to compensate for the lack of space and greenery by creating a public park, with stacked gardens connected by climbers.





Remnant Green Patches in Beirut





This balance in question means incorporating all of the needs and demand of both the neighborhood residents, as well as the daily visitors. 


The brewery cuts through both Mar Mikhael and Geitawi, which are known for narrow streets and alleys. This is why, most people opt to circulate by foot. As the sidewalks are taken over by parked cars, pedestrians have taken over the roads.

As for the main road of Mar Mikhael, Armenia Street currently holds the city's trendiest nightlife. It attracts visitors, from all over Beirut and beyond, every single night. This shows to prove, that food and entertainement are two major attractions in Lebanon.

03.2 | Viewsheds

The brewery takes over entire blocks which indicate different viewsheds from every angle. It has large terraces, clear rooftops, and wide windows at every floor. That said, it is a great opportunity to maximize the use of these views.

These viewsheds overlook the Beirut Port, the sea, the barracks and its French architecture, the colorful neighborhood of Geitawi and the high buildings of Beirut in the background.

03.3 | Open and Vast Floor Plans

One of the first and most important aspects of the brewery that what most appearant is the open and vast floor plans. it is not common to find such a massive and empty two building complex completely in Beirut. And in an extremely tight urban fabric it was only suitable to appropriate the brewery to the public.

However, that would only respond to most of the issues of the areas but help release the stress by incorporating vegetation, as well, by thinking of practical solutions to inevitable daily problems.









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









Concept Plan | Projecting piplines on plan











The brewery had been completely cleared out for decades, and the only remaining elements were the scattered pipes all over the site. This is why, they were the inspiration to the main concept.

Taking the images of the pipe, analysing and abstracting them, the main geometries were formed. These same lines were projected onto the plans to guide the creation of the main path and each floor.

04.2 | Concept



Concept Section | Organization of Activities



Once the main lines were set, it was only a matter of balancing public and private. The two buildings were divided into five blocks, where the private residential blocks were at the extremities and the public blocks at the core. Both buildings have underground parking to accomodate both public and private use.

There are three main central blocks, which functions are projected up to the rooftop:

- Cultural, where a permanant musuem and exhibitions spaces are found;

- Entertainement - a block full of pubs and restaurants which will serve as the initial attraction and the continuous source of income;

- Recreational - A save and large enough enough to gather all activities occuring in the neighborhood.

At each entrance at the ground levels, there is a market (located at the corner closest to Armenia Street), a playground (located slightly higher than the road) and a multipurpose reception area (located right at the heart of teh project).

The main element of the project is a network of pipelines that run across one corner to the next, which serves several functions, from support for climbers, lighting fixtures, hanrails and irrigation and electical ppes. Another interesting feature of this pipeline is that it transforms into bridges which connect both buildings above the street, allowing for a continuous flow of people.

06.0 | Layout Plans

Design Guidelines

-Work on the skin, keeping the skeleton intact, in order not to destroy architectural significance

-Cut slabs on the southern facades in order to benefit on the sun exposure

-Draw lines based on the pipe layouts:


-Follow beams, columns, walls, ceilings to create the design lines;

-Two opposite directions ;

-Different diameters which serve for different functions (Paths, vegetation, irrigation, lighting);

-Flow of resources which could translate into a flow of people;

-Straight pipes and curved right angle which change perspectives wherever you stand.


