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ABSTRACT

Title: 2021: Voyage & Existentialism

A study of the mind, the self, and the human condition.

From a technical standpoint, the project is a dissection of Graphic Design in its various disciplines, as a universal language of communication, and as an instrument of study, culminating four years of accumulated knowledge and practice in the field. The aim is to utilize much of what I have learned, to develop and structure a narrative and design a message in its denoted and connoted forms such that I can successfully communicate the various thematic elements and undertones to its recipient. The work challenges the boundaries of the publication format and the conventional structure of story, and explores the way in which artifacts hold value. The content is fragmented and dispersed across a range of disparate material enclosed inside a folio. Every part a puzzle piece, that sets the reader on a trail of their choice and asks them to investigate and assimilate the information provided by its parts, in order to make the story whole and uncover and complete the intended meaning behind it, through a non conventional, non sequential, and non linear form of progression. This allows the reader a unique experience of reception and reconstruction, whilst providing an opening for personal interpretation.

The meaning is carried by a science fiction narrative, that provides a scope from which we can observe, analyze, and deconstruct the world at a distance, and figure out where our place in it lies, enabling us to see the issues that have become far too embedded in the everyday routine that go by unseen, and thus providing an opportunity for commentary on these issues. The readers position however is not passive and detached but active and involved alongside the central character of the story, who holds up mirror to the person following along.

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ORIGINS

Initially for my final year project, I knew I wanted to embark on a journey to explore and discover without knowing. What I would seek, I would find either within or elsewhere in the stretch of land I travel. Not knowing what I was searching for was in itself interesting an exciting to me. The notion of venturing into the unknown, and searching without knowing, and without aim, could provide me with a fresh and broadened perspective in my journey, and allow me to notice things that would otherwise go unseen, and hence permit me to find more.

In time, as I developed an interest in space, and started to lean more towards my passion for story-telling, I was able to close in on my topic. A science fiction narrative set in space, told through the recovered journal of a traveler, that documents a journey across a collection of archives, schematics, documents, photographs, and other miscellaneous items. The work would be allegorical, drawing parallels to humanity and human civilization, asking questions about our existence, our purpose, and the state of our occupation in the world, as well as what lies on the horizon ahead.

I want the reader to follow along, and to take on an investigative role in trying to uncover and derive meaning as they progress through the pages of the work, with the intent that the themes they will find will be relevant, and relatable to whomever they may be, wherever they may come from, and whenever they may come across the work. To accomplish this, the work needs to be open. Narrative elements present but subtle, and the meaning fragmented and dispersed along it's recesses, for the curious reader to find, piece together, and interpret for themselves.

The Design Question

It is a question of communicating a fragmented storyline and its themes through design.Of grasping the readers attention, and inviting them to embark on a trail to read closely into the work.

PROCESS

My project is not canonically titled, so I started developing an identity, and thinking about the role of branding in story telling and how that pertains to my project.



2020: Ground Zero

In an early module, I was able to explore my project further, by laying the groundwork behind the journey which my character will embark upon in my final year project. It serves as a foundation for the narrative which will follow. I started exploring different visual directions, and working with different elements and techniques, throwing everything that came to mind on the page in front of me. I began to narrow things down towards something more focused and clear.

I developed a prologue. I set out to explore the conflict which would set the narrative and its events in motion. I established a threat under which a world is caught in turmoil. A setting which was politically ruptured by debate, conspiracy, and misconception.

Propaganda has surfaced to create a movement in the heart of the streets, raising awareness and urgency around the situation. A call to action targeting the fears of each nation, and causing panic and pressure.



DELIVERABLES

Throughout the different modules, I developed a solid base for an approach, and a narrative which I will develop further within my fyp, after which I will decide how much to obscure and how the story will be dispersed across its different parts.

Outline of deliverables:

A leather folio containing the following:

-Photographs (Documenting the travellers journey and findings)
 -Polaroids (Classed separately from the main photographic element, serving a lesser purpose. documenting past findings. providing backstory)
 -Documents / Medical Records / Letters (Providing intel on character, mission, and narrative)
 -Shchematics (Providing intel on the items, technology, and transportation meth ods used, with narrative centered implications)
 -Manual / Brochure (Intel on the mission)
 -Comic strip (Narrative implications)
 -Patches / Miscellaneous Items (Provide added tangeblity to the work. A souvenir for lasting impact)



Drought, starvation, and blight drive new waves up north as heatwave persists. Ile. Some conspiracy theorists have even gone to the extent of dismissing these efforts as a hoax, and that a solution to save the people was never in place to begin with.
