

Don't Just Look, DO!

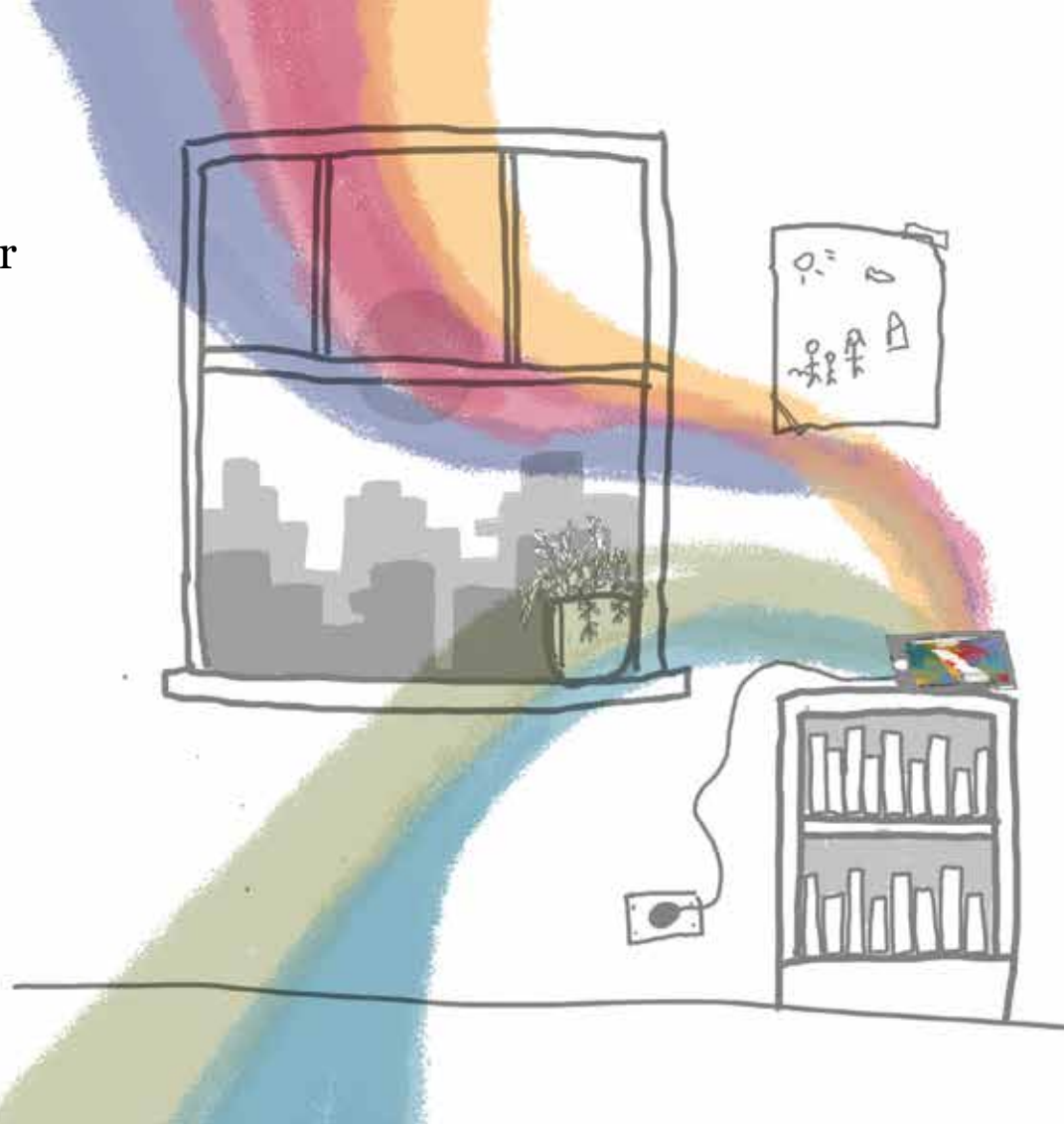

Do this,



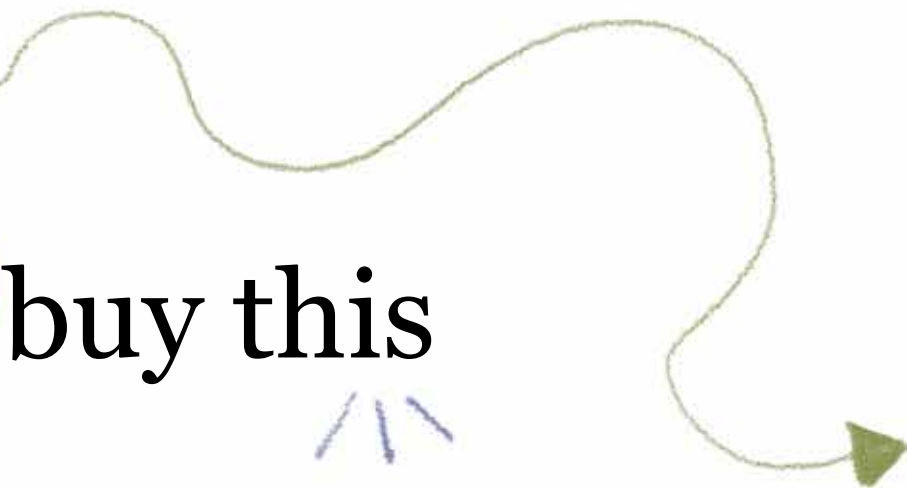
look here!




watch this,
